XI. Eminent Persons visited the institution

During the academic year, as part of seminars and other academic programs, a number of scholars became part of the academic activities of the institution. In December 2021, as part of Sastrasadas, eminent Sanskrit scholars participated in the discussions. This was done in virtual mode. During the Pareekshith memorial lecture series, notable personalities in the field of Sanskrit like Dr. Baladevand Sagar, Dr. H.H Viswas presented their views. Dr. K B Subbarayudu, renowned scholar of Indian philosophy, visited the institution during May 2022.

XII. College Union Election

Election to the college union was held during the final phase of the academic year. Kumari Praveena V B was elected as the Chairperson of the college union.

XIII. RUSA

Infrastructure development under the scheme RUSA was started in the academic year. An amount of Rs. 20000000 was sanctioned under this head. Construction of classrooms is going on along with the renovation of the college auditorium under this scheme.

XIV. KIFBI

As part of the rebuilding Kerala initiatives of Govt. of Kerala, constructions of new academic cum administrative block and canteen are started. An amount of 5. 77 crore is estimated for this purpose.

XV. Ladies' Hostel

Construction of ladies hostel under the Plan fund of the state government is completed. There is the residential facility for more than 50 students in the hostel. Rs. 4.72 crore was utilized for this purpose.
