

- ii) **Extension Programmes:** To conduct seminars, workshops and symposia on all the areas of research mentioned above and also on topics not mentioned hitherto wherein Sanskrit language and contents written in it have reference or relevance in the modern context.
- iii) **Manuscript Preservation:** To catalogue, prepare meta-data and publish unpublished manuscripts by sharing or providing subject expertise and editorial assistance.
- iv) **Publication:** To publish books which are rare and out-of-print, provide editorial assistance to publications of faculty-members and bring out commemorative volumes.

Article III: Consultation and Exchange of Information

3.1 The parties shall, on a regular basis, keep each other informed of and consult on matters of common interest, which in their opinion are likely to lead to mutual collaboration.

3.2 The parties shall at such intervals as deemed appropriate convene meetings to review the progress of activities being carried out under the present MoU and to plan future activities.

Article IV: Implementation of the MoU

4.1 In order to implement the specific activities envisioned hereunder, the parties shall conclude agreements to optimize sharing of resources and expertise in the form of books and persons, subject to existing government regulations, rules and procedures.

4.2 In order to oversee the process, it is desirable to constitute a committee comprising six nominated members, three from each institution. Plans of action are to be evolved from mutual discussions and deliberations.

Article V: Duration, Termination, Modification

5.1. The proposed cooperation under this MoU is non-exclusive and shall have a duration of an initial period of three years, commencing with the 13th day of

..... Feb. 2023 and ending on the 12th day of Feb. 2026, unless terminated earlier by either party upon three months' notice in writing to the other party. The parties may agree to extend this MoU for subsequent periods of two years.

5.2. In the event of termination of the MoU, the knowledge-sharing agreements and project documents concluded pursuant to this MoU may also be terminated in accordance with the termination provision contained in such agreements. In such case, the parties shall take the necessary steps to ensure that the activities carried out under the MoU, the knowledge-sharing agreements, and project documents are brought to a prompt and orderly conclusion.

5.3. This MoU may be amended by mutual agreement of the parties reflected in writing.
